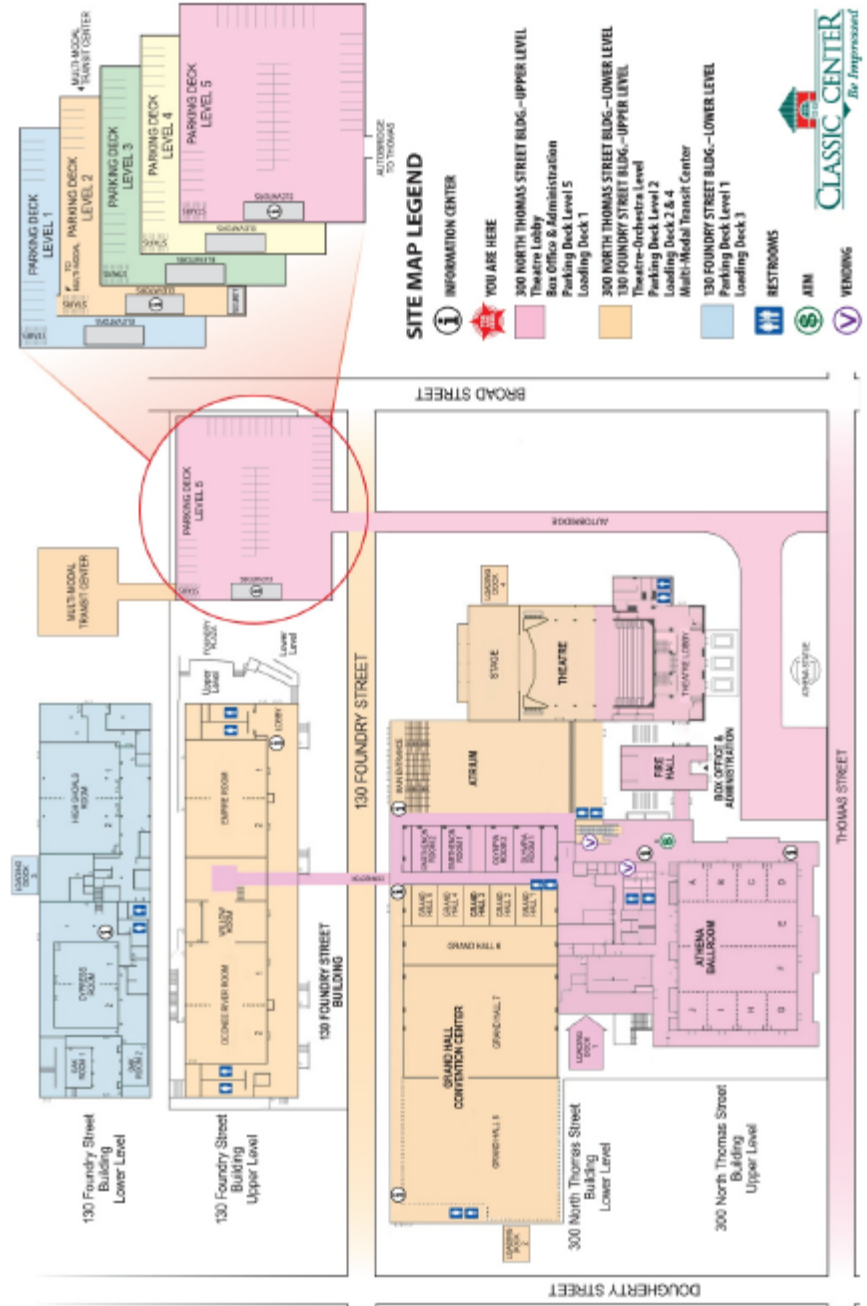

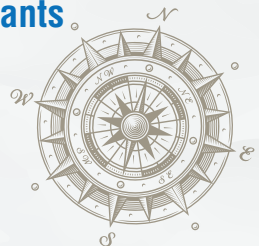

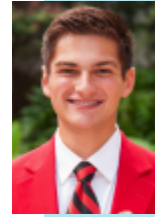


Shivani Dhir

Garrhett Petrea



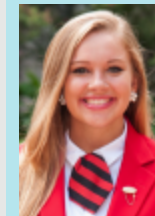
