



Thinc. Week – Georgia FCCLA Competition

Purpose

To encourage FCCLA members to become familiar with entrepreneurship through activities conducted during *Thinc. Week*.

Description

Thinc. Week activities are designed to 1) provide education about entrepreneurship and the *Thinc. Week* initiative, 2) promote opportunities in entrepreneurship and 3) show appreciation to entrepreneurs in the community.

What is *Thinc.*?

Thinc. is an initiative designed to encourage students to see the world of opportunities both local and global, and to start something in response. That “something” might be a new for-profit company or a not-for-profit social venture. It might change something in your own neighborhood or community, or it might change the world. Rules and Procedures

1. The FCCLA chapter applying for recognition must be nationally affiliated.
2. Applications for this award must be properly filled out and received by the March 1 deadline. The application will reflect the FCCLA chapter’s activities conducted during *Thinc. Week*.
3. FCCLA chapters who identify activities in the three areas listed in the description during *Thinc. Week* will receive recognition for their contributions.
4. Certificates will be awarded to all FCCLA chapters who conduct activities during *Thinc. Week* that meet the criteria established in these guidelines.
5. Special recognition will be given to one chapter in each category whose activities are of an outstanding nature and worthy of special recognition.
6. The dates for *Thinc. Week* will be determined by the chapter. Any week can be designated as *Thinc. Week*.

Requirements

Chapters will submit their application online at <https://gafcccla.wufoo.com/forms/thinc-week-application/> by March 1. The application will include a narrative or outline of activities sponsored by the chapter to fulfill each of the three goal areas of *Thinc. Week*. The three areas to be addressed through *Thinc. Week* activities are:

- 1) Provide education about entrepreneurship and the *Thinc. Week* initiative
- 2) Promote opportunities in entrepreneurship and
- 3) Show appreciation to entrepreneurs in the community.

It is up to the local chapter to plan and carry out activities of their choosing that meet the *Thinc. Week* goals. In order to earn a *Thinc. Week* certificate, the chapter must conduct at least one activity in each of the three goal areas during *Thinc. Week*.
