



Scholarship Application Information

- All applicants must have a GPA of no less than 85 (unweighted).
- All scholarships require a minimum of 2 years membership in FCCLA.
- Membership activities should be listed on the application.
- All scholarships are contingent upon an applicant's acceptance letter.
- **Application deadline is February 1.**

Three steps to complete the application process:

1. Applicant completes the online application at the [2018 Scholarship Application](#) link.
2. Three recommendation letters should be uploaded at the [2018 Scholarship Recommendation](#) link:
 - a. One letter from your Family and Consumer Sciences teacher
 - b. One letter from a school official
 - c. One letter from a community leader
3. An official copy of your school record sent to the Georgia FCCLA office by the school office, postmarked by February 1st. (Mail to: Georgia FCCLA, 283 Swanson Drive, Suite 204, Lawrenceville, GA 30043)

Scholarships Available:

ABAC/FCCLA Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must be a resident of Georgia
- Recipient must demonstrate a record of active involvement in FCCLA on the Leadership Activity form via the ABAC Scholarship Application (<http://www.abac.edu/funding-my-education/scholarships>)
- Recipients must have completed the Georgia FCCLA scholarship application
- The recipient must be accepted to ABAC and must have completed the ABAC Scholarship Application (<http://www.abac.edu/funding-my-education/scholarships>)
- Recipient must be enrolled at the College for a full-time course load of twelve (12) or more hours per semester for the entire period of the scholarship award
- Recipient must also be enrolled in coursework in an area of Family and Consumer Sciences at the College
- Recipient must adhere to all College scholarship terms and conditions

Allen-Childs Scholarship - \$250.00

- Recipient must attend a university or college in Georgia.
- Recipient must major in Family and Consumer Sciences Education.
- Must be an active FCCLA member for at least 3 years.
- Must have competed in at least one competitive event.
- Must attend a minimum of two state or national events.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$250.00 will be payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter prior to September 1.

Atlanta Farmer's Club Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- Recipient may major in any field.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$500 will be payable to the registrar of the college upon receipt of an official acceptance letter and prior to September 1.

Frances King Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- The president of the Georgia Association of Teachers of Family and Consumer Sciences (GATFACS) handles funds.

Georgia Association of Family and Consumer Sciences Scholarship - \$250.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- Recipient should major in Family and Consumer Sciences or in a related field of Family and Consumer Sciences.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$250.00 will be payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter prior to September 1.

Inez Murray-Janette Barber-Daisy Lewis Scholarship - \$500.00

- Recipient must attend a university, college or technical college in Georgia.
- This scholarship may be used at a technical college or at a college or university that does not have a true Family and Consumer Sciences Department as long as the field of study is related to Family and Consumer Sciences.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$500.00 will be payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter prior to September 1.

Janette McGarity-Barber Scholarship - \$700.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$700.00 will be sent payable to the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter prior to September 1.

Myrtice Edenfield Scholarship - \$600.00

- Recipient must attend a college or university in Georgia.
- Recipient must be from Region 6 or 7.
- Recipient must major in Family and Consumer Sciences or a related field.
- The State FCCLA Office handles funds in the following manner: \$600 will be sent payable to the registrar of the post-secondary institution upon receipt of an official acceptance letter prior to September 1.
