Georgia FCCLA has updated Culinary Arts guidelines. These guidelines are based off the National FCCLA guidelines. However, there are some major deviations from those guidelines. These deviations are indicated in red font in the guidelines.

### **Equipment**

The following supplies and equipment will be provided by Georgia FCCLA:

- One table
- Protein for the competition

The following supplies and equipment will be provided by the team:

- One speed rack (optional)
- Recipes (as specified in the guidelines)
- Equipment needed for recipes
- Food for recipes (minus the protein)
- Maximum of 2 butane burners
- Note: This is not necessarily an exhaustive list, refer to the guidelines for other needed supplies

### **Equipment Rental**

There are options to rent butane burners (\$15) and butane canisters (\$5) through the registration system.

### **Multiple Release Forms**

Each adviser will have completed Multiple Release Forms for each participant. These forms will remain in the adviser's possession during the competition.

### **State Leadership Conference**

The State Culinary Arts STAR Event will take place during the State Leadership Conference, March 9-11 in Atlanta. The top two teams from each region (providing these teams reach silver medal status) will earn the right to compete at the State Leadership Conference in the Culinary Arts STAR Event.
