

Email sent out on Wednesday, January 3, 2018 regarding State Leadership Conference deadlines:

Good evening,

I hope that everyone has had a restful break and is ready for an exciting spring semester with Georgia FCCLA!

I have had several advisers email me with questions regarding the deadlines for the 2018 State Leadership Conference. I wanted to take a moment and address some of these questions, so you will have all the information you need to effectively plan your semester.

As you know, we are in a new venue this year for our event and there are some hotel deadlines that have impacted our registration deadlines. **Please take note of these new deadlines for State Leadership Conference registration:**

- **Early Bird Deadline – ends on February 8th at midnight**
- **Regular Registration Deadline – ends on February 15th at midnight**
- **Hotel Room Registration Deadline – ends on February 15th at midnight**

I am fully aware that the Early Bird Deadline is **before** the Region STAR Events competition. If you wish to have your students receive the early bird discounts, you **MUST** register them before February 8th at midnight.

Once the list of competitors who have advanced to state has been released, you will have a few days to log back into the registration system and delete any students who are no longer going to attend the State Leadership Conference. Students not attending the conference **MUST** be deleted out of the registration system before registration ends on February 15th at midnight.

Please be aware that it will be up to the adviser to log back in and delete any students out (if needed). When registration closes on the 15th, chapters will be responsible for the **ENTIRE** invoice regardless of who attends the conference.

I know that this is different than what has been done in the past, and I greatly appreciate your flexibility in this matter. I am currently working on next year's calendar and will adjust the calendar as needed to ensure that the deadlines will return to normal for next year.
