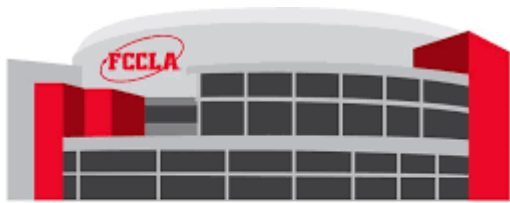

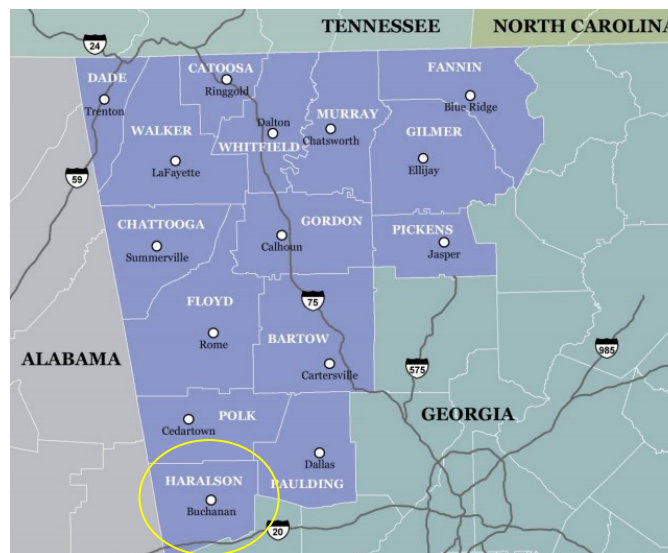

The recently-completed Haralson County Business and Industry Needs Survey indicates strong local trends that are also driving the Culinary Arts & Tourism industry:

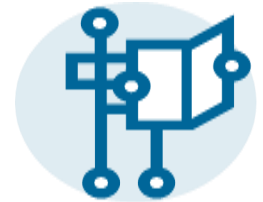
