Ribbon	Criteria	What Can I Do?
25+ Chapter	<i>Chapter has 25-49 members</i>	Your chapter's membership numbers will be pulled from the FCCLA Portal on February 1 st . Schools will receive their respective ribbons based on how many paid, affiliated members they have on February 1 st .
50+ Chapter	<i>Chapter has 50-74 members</i>	
75+ Chapter	<i>Chapter has 75-99 members</i>	
100+ Chapter	<i>Chapter has 100-149 members</i>	
150+ Chapter	<i>Chapter has 150-199 members</i>	
200+ Chapter	<i>Chapter has more than 200 members</i>	
Adopt-A-Chapter	<i>Adopt a Middle or High School, Serve as Mentor</i>	Fill out the State Programs Wufoo Form and let us know how you have adopted a chapter!
Career Connection	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the Career Connection National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Community Service	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the Career Connection National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Courtesy Corps	<i>Sign up to be a STAR Events Runner or Usher</i>	Register members to be Courtesy Corps at SLC!
FACTS	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the FACTS National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Families First	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the Families First National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Financial Fitness	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the Financial Fitness National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Fund Donor	<i>Donate to Georgia FCCLA Causes</i>	Complete the Donation Form and submit proper "payment" documentation by February 1 st .
Graduating Senior	<i>Be a 12th Grader</i>	Click the "Graduating Senior" button in the registration system for your seniors.
Honor Roll	<i>Submit an Honor Roll scorecard and documentation</i>	Submit Honor Roll scorecard and documentation PowerPoint by January 31 st . Must earn at least 225 points when graded by the Honor Roll committee.
Honor Roll with Distinction	<i>Submit an Honor Roll scorecard and documentation</i>	Submit an Honor Roll scorecard and documentation PowerPoint by January 31 st . Must earn at least 300 points when graded by the Honor Roll committee.
Legislative Connection	<i>Connect with your legislators and advocate</i>	Fill out the State Programs Wufoo Form and let us know how your chapter has made a Legislative Connection.
National Outreach Project	<i>Participate in Lead4Change</i>	Sign up to participate and fill out the State Programs Wufoo Form and let us know how your chapter has completed Lead4Change.

Power of One	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Check off which students have completed Power of One inside your chapter's FCCLA Portal. Then, submit each member's documentation on this Wufoo Form . State recognition deadline (with documentation) – February 1 st National recognition deadline (with documentation) – March 1 st
Say Yes to FCS	<i>Promote FCS and Education Careers</i>	Fill out the State Programs Wufoo Form and let us know how your chapter has promoted Say Yes to FCS.
STAR Events Competitor	<i>Be a STAR Events Competitor</i>	Compete in STAR Events! Students will be given this ribbon during STAR Events Orientation.
State Event Competitor	<i>Be a State Events Competitor</i>	Compete in a state event! Students will be given this ribbon during their State Event Orientation.
STOP the Violence	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the STOP the Violence National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Student Body	<i>Submit a National Program Application</i>	Submit the Student Body National Program Award on the FCCLA Portal by February 1 st for state recognition.
Voting Delegate	<i>Be a Voting Delegate</i>	All chapters will be given one Voting Delegate ribbon in their registration packets.

Ribbon	Criteria	What Can I Do?
Board of Directors	<i>Member of the Board of Directors</i>	Apply to be on the Board of Directors next year!
FCCLA Adviser	<i>Be an FCCLA Adviser</i>	Be your awesome self – no documentation needed.
Lead Consultant	<i>Be a STAR Events Lead Consultant</i>	Let us know you're interested in volunteering!
STAR Events Judge	<i>Be a STAR Events Judge</i>	Judge a STAR Event. Judges ribbons will be given out at Judges Orientation.
State Officer Adviser/Region Officer Adviser	<i>Be a 2019-2020 State or Region Officer Adviser</i>	Advisers to the 2018-2019 State Executive Council will receive their respective ribbons.
Region Adviser	<i>Be a Georgia FCCLA Region Adviser</i>	Region Advisers will receive a Region Adviser ribbon.
