# Transitioning to Region Officer Teams!

- More leadership opportunities for students
- Growing your region's activities
- Strengthen the roles of state officers vs. region officers
- Helps prepare students for running for state office





# Region Officer Duties and Responsibilities (Team)

- Attend the Region Officer Team training in June.
- Create and send monthly emails to advisers in the region
- Maintain up-to-date region website.
- Receive chapter spotlights and post them to region website.



# Region Officer Duties and Responsibilities (Team)

- Maintain up-to-date social media accounts.
- Attend the Fall Region Conference.
- Develop leadership sessions for the Fall Region Conference.
- Attend and assist Region Adviser with Region STAR Events competition





# Region Officer Duties and Responsibilities (Team)

- Design and execute the Region Awards Ceremony at the State Leadership Conference



# Region Officer Duties and Responsibilities (Individual)

- Check email daily.
- Submit monthly report to Region Adviser
- Attend two school visits





# Region Officer Duties and Responsibilities (Suggested, but not required)

- Quarterly conference calls with the Executive Director
- Attend DISCOVER Training
- Attend Fall Rally
- Attend Fall Leadership Conference
- Attend State Leadership Conference



# Running for Region Office

- Application
- Online Qualification Test
- Selection Committee
- Announcement of Region Officer Teams





# Running for Region Office

- Application – Due April 17<sup>th</sup>
  - Two-page FCCLA resume
  - Other accomplishments/honors
  - Two recommendation letters
  - Transcript
  - Video responses
  - Written Responses
  - Signature Pages



# Travel Policies

- First and foremost, students must follow local district travel policies
- Allowed to transport themselves to chapter and business and industry visits within the region – sign travel document





# Travel Policies

- Region officer's school or school system and/or parents/guardians are responsible for providing transportation to all other events



# Financials

- Georgia FCCLA will pay for meals at June Region Officer Training
- Georgia FCCLA will purchase a black officer polo for each officer
- Region officers must purchase the rest of the uniform – black pants, khaki pants, black flats/loafers





# Responsibilities for Chapter Advisers

- By going to region officer teams, chapter advisers will have less responsibility than the current region officer model
- Attend Region Officer Training in June



# Responsibilities for Chapter Advisers

- Oversee (check up on...) region officers on:
  - Sending monthly emails
  - Region websites
  - Chapter spotlights
  - Social media accounts
  - Leadership sessions at FRC





# Responsibilities for Chapter Advisers

- Arrange transportation to and from events (if needed)
- Communicate with officer on a regular basis
