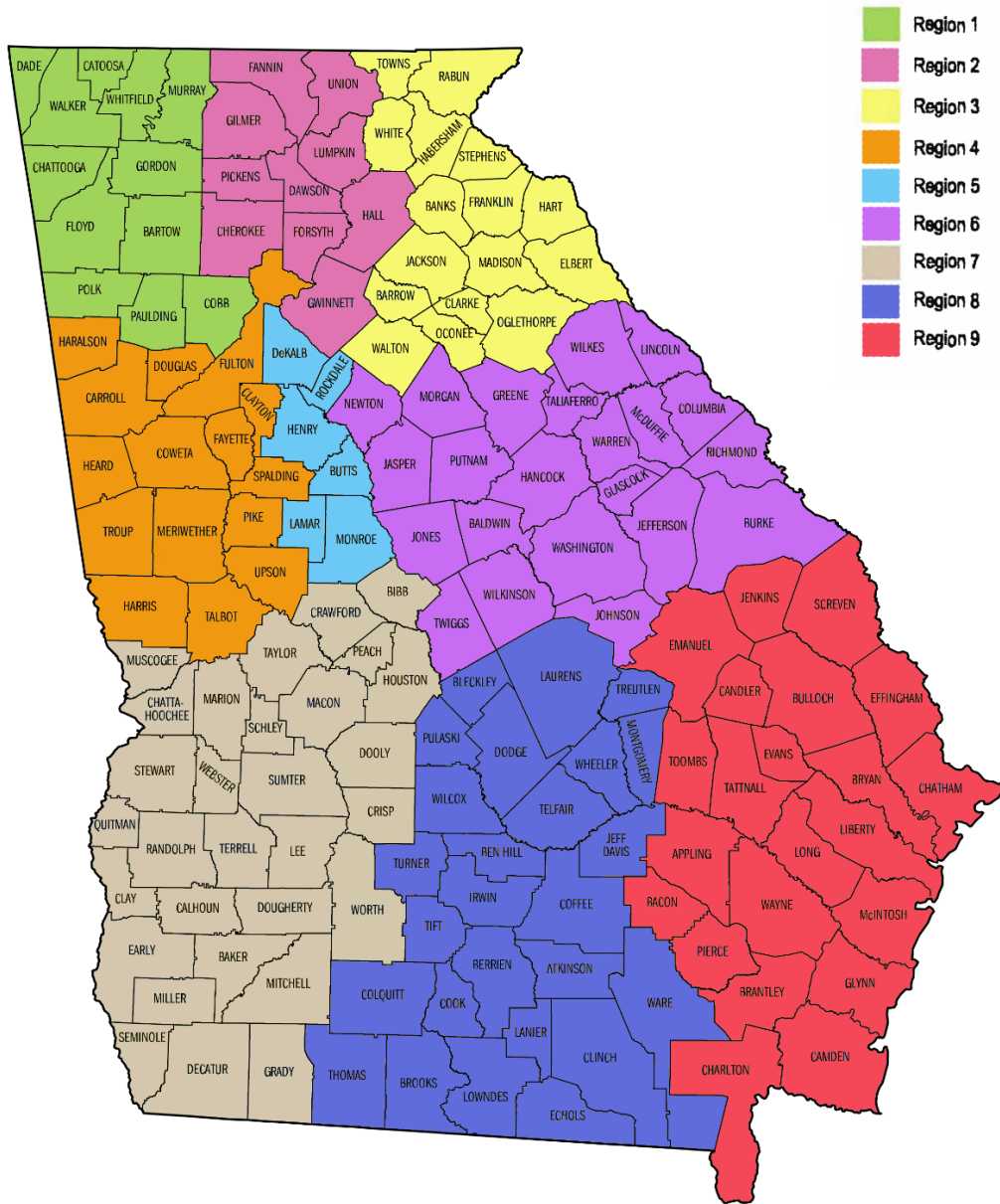

Special Accommodations

Deadline to submit Special Accommodations: January 21st, 2023

For Members that require special accommodations, complete the special needs portion in the Region STAR Events Conference Management/Registration System. Examples of reason that students may need special accommodations would include, but are not limited to are: wheelchair access, interpreter services, specific services listed on the student's IEP.

Dress Code:

From the National FCCLA STAR Event Guidelines for Baking and Pastry and Culinary Arts STAR Events

Uniform and Appearance

Participants will be well groomed and wear appropriate, clean attire meeting the following standards:

Uniform, Jewelry and Personal Hygiene	Clean and appropriate <i>uniform</i> including <i>professional</i> chef attire (chef coat/jacket; industry pants or commercial <i>uniform</i> pants; apron; hair covering or chef hat; closed-toe, low heel, kitchen shoes made with non-slip soles and sealed non-melting uppers (canvas shoes are not appropriate)). No additional jewelry, with the exception of a watch, is allowed. Facial hair is permitted if appropriate covering is used. Hair is properly restrained with hairnet if hair extends past the neck line. Minimal makeup, no cologne or nail polish. Acceptable graphics on the Culinary Arts uniform include the FCCLA logo, school, chapter, or state name or logo, and individual name. No additional logos are permitted. If required, additional logos may be covered with white cloth tape.
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Please note that the only change for the Dress Code for Georgia FCCLA Region and State Culinary Competitions is for the chef jacket. Acceptable graphics on the Culinary Arts uniform include the FCCLA Logo or Georgia FCCLA Logo. Please refrain from including the school, chapter, or individual name on the chef jacket. Masking tape or painters tape will be available at the competition location to cover any school, chapter, or individual names on the chef jacket. Georgia FCCLA follows this procedure to ensure that integrity of the evaluation of the food products is made without bias based on the individual's chapter.

Region STAR Events Recognition

Each student registered by the regular registration deadline will receive a certificate with their name and a sticker depicting a Gold, Silver, or Bronze rating.

The process to return scoresheets: Score sheets may be picked up by the adviser only at the end of all event competitions. If you do not wish to wait on score sheets they will be scanned and emailed to the primary adviser on Monday, February 20th, 2023.

The top two individuals/teams from each event category will be eligible for State STAR Events Competition, providing the score is in the SILVER or GOLD rating.

Multiple teams/individuals may receive a GOLD or SILVER rating and not be placed in 1st or 2nd for their level of competition. This is due to the National FCCLA STAR Events Rubrics. Teams/Individuals that receive a score of 90 and above will receive Gold. Teams/Individuals that receive a score of 70-89.99 will receive Silver. Depending on the actual score of each competitor will determine the top 2 of each STAR Event.

The list of competitors advancing to the State STAR Events will be available on the Georgia FCCLA website by Tuesday following the Region STAR Events at the latest.

FCCLA Code of Conduct for Region STAR Events

FCCLA members and advisers should follow the following guidelines while attending a Georgia FCCLA sponsored event:

1. Member/Competitor's behavior always should be such that it reflects a positive, professional image of you, your chapter, your state and the organization.
2. Members/Competitors shall keep their adult advisers always informed of their activities and whereabouts.
3. Local advisers will be responsible for their Members/Competitor s' conduct.
4. Members/Competitors will attend the Competitor Orientation and Competition.
5. Members/Competitor s will be prompt and prepared for all activities.
6. The dress code will be enforced at all times. (The Dress Code is listed in the Adviser Guide.)
7. Any accidents, injuries or illnesses should be reported to the adult chaperone, chapter adviser, Region Adviser or State Adviser/Executive Director immediately.
8. Inappropriate physical conduct is not allowed and will be subject to disciplinary action.
9. If a student is found responsible for stealing or vandalism, the student and his/her parents/guardians will be expected to pay all damages.
10. Members/Competitors attending the FCCLA Conference may not purchase, possess, consumer or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action.
11. Smoking, vaping, or the possession of tobacco, is not allowed.
12. Members/Competitors violating or ignoring any of the conduct rules will subject their entire chapter delegation to being unseated and their candidates or competitive events contestants (if applicable) being disqualified at the 2023 State Leadership Conference. Individual Members/Competitors who disregard the rules will be subject to disciplinary action and be sent home at their own expense. In the case of student Members/Competitors, parents/guardians will be notified.
